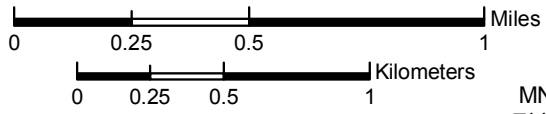
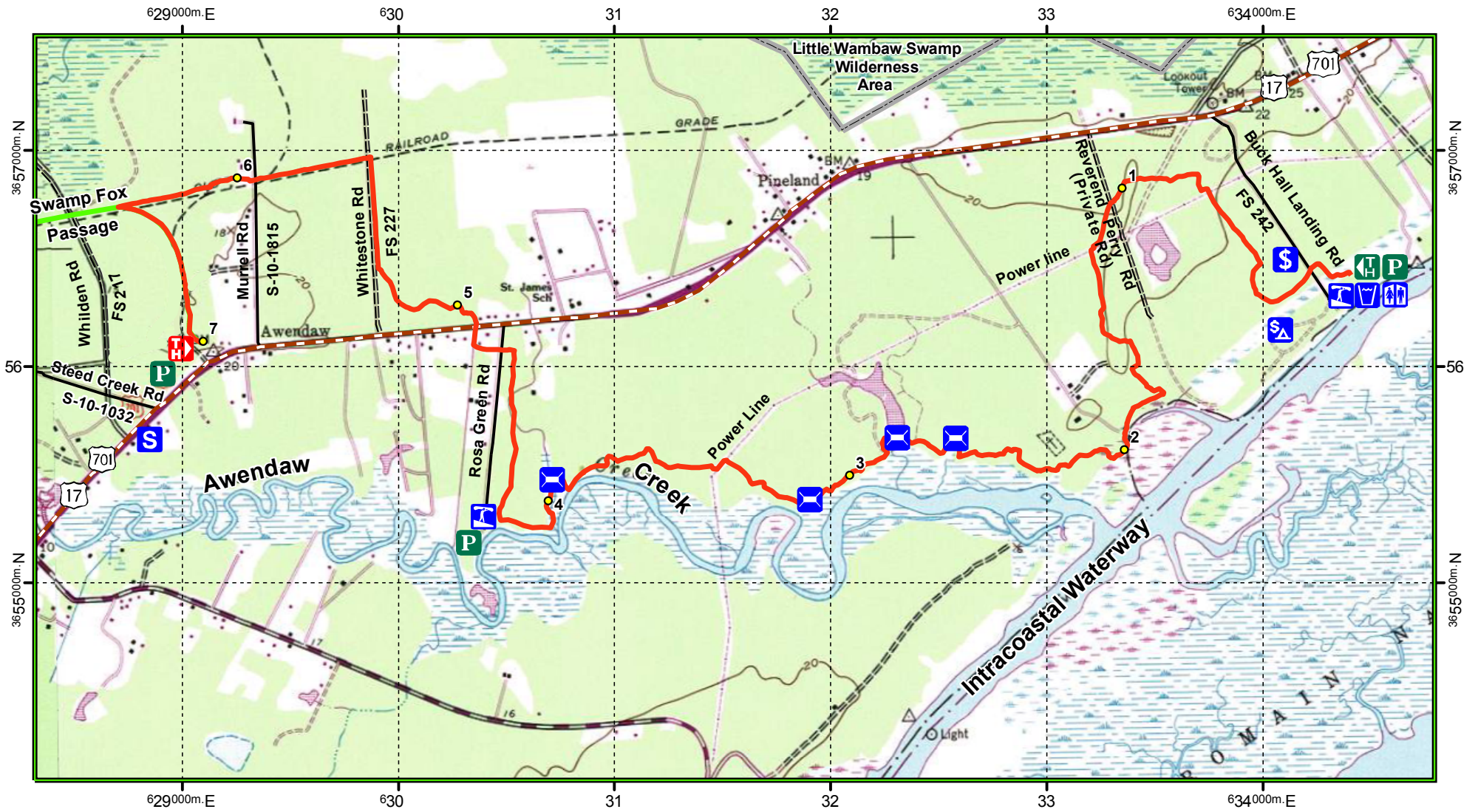


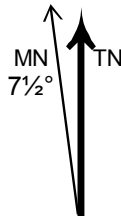
Awendaw Passage of the Palmetto Trail

RULES & PRECAUTIONS

DRIVING DIRECTIONS:

Buck Hall Recreation Area Trailhead (eastern trailhead): Buck Hall is located approximately 30 miles north of Charleston on Highway 17. The entrance sign to Buck Hall is on the east side of the road, three miles past the trailhead at Steed Creek Road. It's a half-mile down the road to the trailhead and parking area.

Swamp Fox Trailhead (western trailhead): Highway 17 north from Charleston to Steed Creek Road (SC 1032). Trailhead and parking is on west side of the road, .25 miles past Steed Creek Rd. Traveling north, you will have to drive past the trailhead and make a U-turn at the next crossover.
